Take part in our challenge to visit every station and you will create a colorful, fun keychain to take home. Activity stations staffed by Wisconsin 4-H Youth Development specialists, educators and volunteers and other UW-Extension staff.

Stage Area: Enjoy performances by the Wisconsin 4-H Showcase Singers and county 4-H groups throughout the day.


Celebrate the Wisconsin 4-H Centennial with 4-H Day at the Wisconsin State Fair
